

COMMUNITY MESSAGING IN NORTHUMBERLAND

BE INFORMED

Please find the following Coquetdale Community Message update covering the period 1st April to 28th April 2015.

Five (5) x crimes were reported over this period:

Rothbury

Burglary Dwelling - Coquetdale Apartments

Occurred between 02/04/15 and 03/04/15

The elderly victim reports money having been removed from a draw and her purse within this ground floor residential flat.

CID enquiries are continuing.

Officer in the Case (OIC) PC Rob Kilburn

Police are visiting vulnerable elderly people in the Hillside area of Rothbury for reassurance and to remind people to be vigilant in respect to visitors, persons who work or frequent the local area, also to keep doors and windows locked.

There have been no threats or violence to anyone however, police have concerns following several incidents reported over a 9 month period where money, jewellery or obscure items such as cheese going missing.

Please be vigilant and immediately report any concerns to police via the 999 system.

Also please ensure any neighbour, relative or friend in the area is made aware.

If any potential vulnerable person would benefit from a personal police officer visit, please let us know (reply to this email)

Police focus and presence will continue.

Criminal Damage - Walby Hill area

Occurred 23/04/15 where several election signs were damaged and removed from a private garden area.

Police enquiries are continuing with interventions in place to deter further such damage.

Such aggravated form of criminal damage, linked to interference with local democracy will result in prosecution.

Thropton / Snitter

Firearms related crime (No shot gun certificate)

Reported 09/04/15 and is linked to a firearms enquiry officer visit to a farm in the Thropton area.
A person was found in possession of a shotgun without the required certificate.
A local male (36 years) was cautioned for the offence

Swarland / Longframlington

Burglary Other Than Dwelling - Sunnyside, Newton on the Moor

Occurred daytime 01/04/15 where person/s entered an insecure outbuilding and removed quantities of fire wood to the value of £50

Harbottle / Alwinton / Elsdon / Rothley areas

Assault - Actual Bodily Harm - Harbottle main street.

Occurred 11am 13/04/15 following a verbal altercation between a resident and lorry driver attempting to pass through the village with a wide load.

The driver (46 yrs from Gateshead), grabbed hold of the male victim (58 yrs), by the throat and forced him back onto the footway, causing throat and neck injuries.

Enquiries are continuing with the driver interviewed.

FRAUD

- Be wary of fake agricultural machinery on auction websites, advertising property for sale that does not exist
- Also bogus websites claiming to be the official site of National Savings & Investments, where cold callers have been directing people to access.
- Suggest hang up on cold callers and never provide any personal or banking information
- Door step visitors - **If in doubt, keep them out.**
- Protect yourself and seek prior advice.
